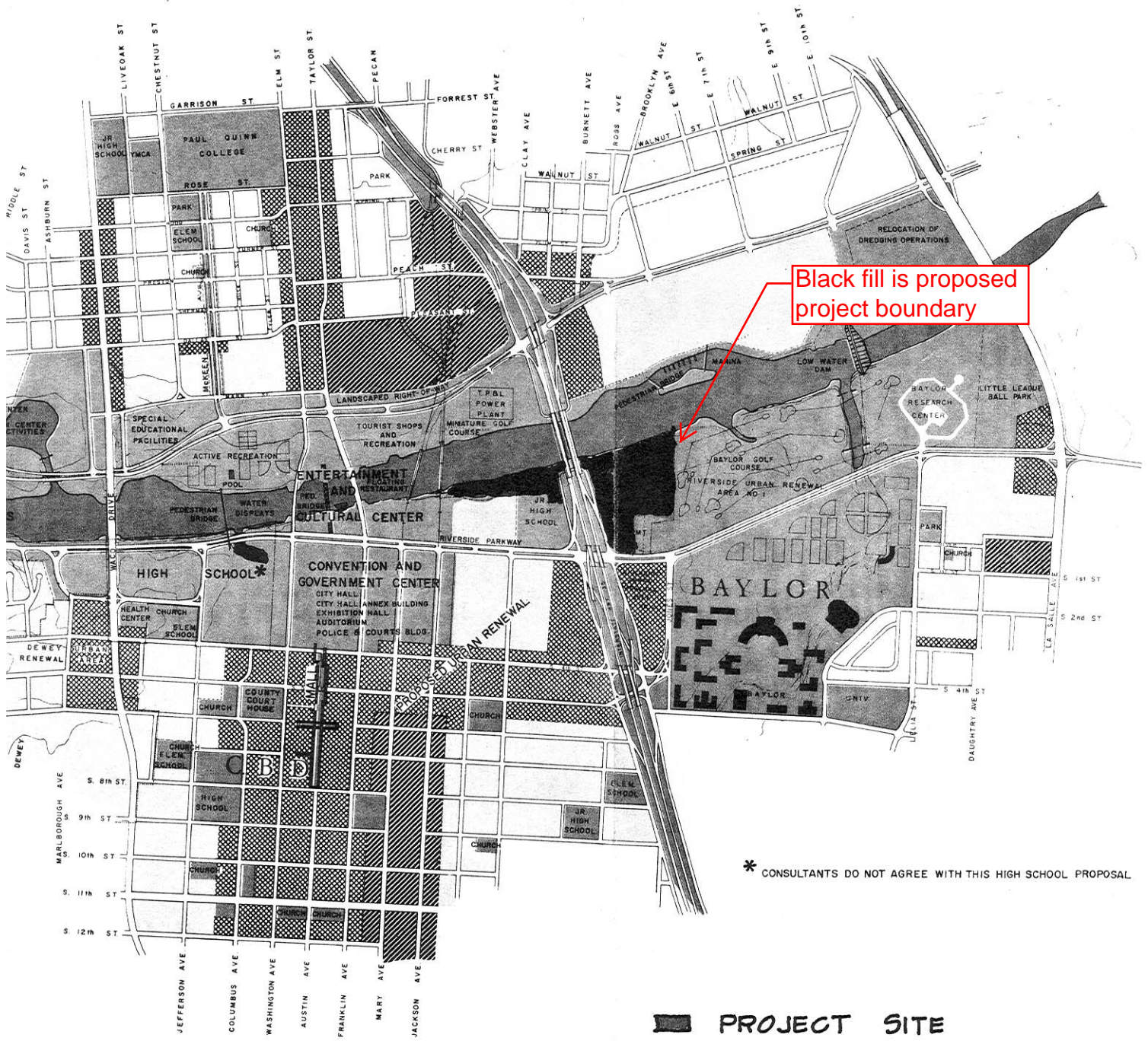


D-660-2 The following maps, charts, pictures and brochures are attached:

1. A City of Waco strip map showing the entire area of the proposed Lake Brazos Recreation Project. This map will include existing and proposed roadways, existing and proposed land uses, the proposed location of the Lake Brazos Low Water Dam, the proposed side of the Fort Fisher, Historical Cemetery, and camping area. This map also shows the overall land use plan of this area.
2. A master plan of the proposed Fort Fisher, Historical Cemetery and Camping Area.

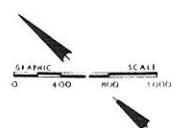
